Impact Video

Purpose

This assignment is designed to help students view the impact of charitable giving through a different, more personal lens; you will be asked to do some introspection and determine the impact of a charitable act or gift that you have personally received.

Assignment

You will be asked to do some introspection and determine the impact of a charitable act or gift that you have personally received. Consider instances you have been the recipient of someone else's generosity; are you a scholarship recipient? Have you been part of a sports team that has only functioned due to successful fundraisers? Has someone donated to a cause that directly impacted you (mission, service trip, etc.)? If not the recipient of financial generosity, have you been the recipient of someone's gift of time or talent?

Select one of these instances and record a short video of yourself that includes these components:

- Address your benefactor (the person, persons, or group)
- Verbally identify the gift you received
- Articulate the ways in which their gift impacted you; start with the quantitative impact (I was
 able to attend one semester of school that I would not have otherwise been able to attend) and
 move to qualitative/anecdotal (I was able to identify my passion for veterinary care and on my
 way to becoming a full-fledged animal doctor)
- Demonstrate gratitude
